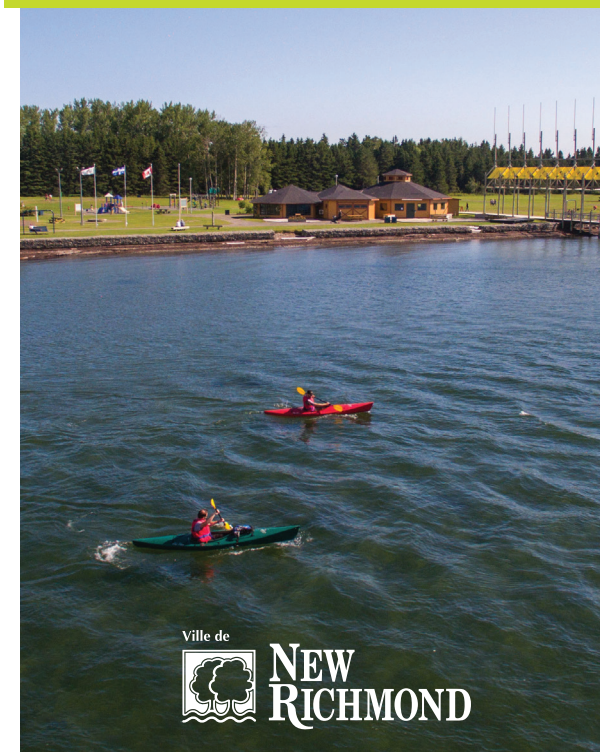

### NEW RICHMOND DAY CAMP

The New Richmond Day Camp has been recognized as a certified camp by the Association des camps du Québec since 2016! The day camp is for children 5 to 11 years of age. Activities include: outdoor games, cultural activities, sports and outdoor

activities and lots of fun. The New Richmond Day Camp will be open from **June 28 to August 13, 2021.**

Due to the pandemic and the new directives for municipal day camps, the number of participants will be considerably decreased for the 2021 edition. The Town of New Richmond reserves the right to review registrations once the maximum capacity has been attained.

### Registration procedures:

You must complete the registration and medical history forms for your child (2 forms per child) that will be available **beginning on May 31<sup>st</sup> online or the paper version that will be available at the Town Hall.** Please note that returning completed registration forms does not guarantee a place at the day camp. You will be contacted to confirm your registration (we will proceed on a first come, first served basis). The completed forms must be returned to the Recreation Department **before 16:00 on June 11, 2021, either by email to [lduguay@villeneuve-richmond.com](mailto:lduguay@villeneuve-richmond.com) or in person at the New Richmond Town Hall.**

**Registration obligatory before June 11, 2021 (No additional registration forms will be accepted after this date)**

### Payment schedule

It is possible to pay day camp fees using a credit card by telephone at 418 392-7000, extension 9-232. We encourage you to take advantage of this method of payment by telephone.

**First installment (50%):** payable on June 14, 2021 by telephone at 418 392-7000, extension

9-232 or in person at the New Richmond Town Hall from 9:00 to 12:00 and from 13:00 to 16:00.

### Second installment (balance of 50%):

payable on July 12, 2021 by telephone at 418 392-7000, extension 9-232 or in person at the New Richmond Town Hall from 9:00 to 12:00 and from 13:00 to 16:00.
