A message from the Mayor

Dear citizens:

Winter will soon be here. All of our municipal departments are working to prepare for the winter season. Evidently, our Public Works Department will be ready to confront winter conditions in order to offer us a high-quality service, our trees and flowerbeds are being prepared for cold weather, our arena is in operation and everything is set up to complete the work sites that begin in 2018. I am referring to sections of Cyr Road and Saint-Edgar Road, the construction of the Avenue des Érables and the repair work to the water and sewerage network in the eastern section of the town. These 4 worksites constitute a large investment for our town and a great deal of work for the Town personnel. But, first and foremost, this work will have resulted in a huge improvement to the services offered to our citizens and I am extremely proud of this fact.

As winter is approaching, it will soon be time to think about the holiday season. Once again this year, the Town of New Richmond will be offering a diversified program for the 16th edition of the Christmas on the Gaspé event. I would like to mention that we will celebrate the arrival of Santa Claus in our town with a parade on Friday, November 30th, beginning at 18:30. Merchants and organizations are invited to participate by building a float. The traditional activity of the lighting of the Christmas Tree at the Town Hall will take place on November 17th. The complete program will be available on our website very soon. One of our main objectives is a lively and dynamic town and this type of activity is essential to achieving this goal. I invite everyone to participate.

I also hope that a large number of citizens will participate in the public information meeting concerning the future of the arena. As previously mentioned, the population is invited to this meeting on **November 12th at 19:00** at the *Salle de spectacles régionale Desjardins* to learn about the results of the study completed in June by the *Centre d'initiation à la recherche et d'aire au développement durable (CIRADD)* concerning the evolution of sports and recreation requirements of clients and potential clients of the arena. Parallel to this study, we mandated architects and engineering professionals to prepare a detailed evaluation of the condition of the building and to calculate the costs to renovate it in function of the needs identified by clients. The results will also be presented at this meeting. Because of the size, and costs of this infrastructure in New Richmond, its importance to the community and in function of current demographical and social tendencies, the future of this facility merits a great deal of serious reflection. This is how we have approached this issue, as outlined in our 2018-2021 Strategic Plan of Actions. Even if you are currently not a client of the arena, I encourage you to attend because the decision making process in the next few years for a central town such as ours is far from being simple. The entire community should be informed about this decision-making process, and, above all, have an opportunity to make constructive comments that will contribute to this process. This is the way that we will conduct this meeting and subsequent ones. I sincerely hope that a large number of citizens will participate. In the meantime, have an excellent month of November.

The 2018 edition of Culture Days in New Richmond A HUGE SUCCESS!

New Richmond, October 2, 2018 – On Sunday, September 30th the activity, *La culture Mi'gmaq*, took place at the *Salle de spectacles régionale Desjardins* of New Richmond. This activity was part of the 14th edition of *Culture Days* in New Richmond, an event that celebrates culture throughout Quebec.

Beginning at 13:30, the 237 visitors had an opportunity to admire the ancestral method of basket making demonstrated by Stephen Jerome in the lobby of the auditorium.

Following this, the activity continued in the large auditorium with an impressive and much-appreciated show by Darlene Jerome who sang her own traditional aboriginal songs, accompanied by 8 dancers.

The activity ended in the large auditorium with the presentation of 8 short films produced by Wapikoni about the aboriginal culture, in collaboration with *Ciné Bobine*.

Participants were eligible for a drawing for 2 books entitled: *NTA'TUGWAQANMINEN NOTRE HISTOIRE – Évolution des Mi'gmans de Gaspé'gwa'gi*, written by Danielle E. Cyr in collaboration with the Gesgapegiag community. The winners were Chloé Poirier and Pierre-Alain Bujold.

This free activity was made possible thanks to the cultural development agreement between the Town of New Richmond and the Minister of Culture and Communications of Quebec.

FAMILY AND SENIORS POLICY

New Richmond, October 1, 2018 – Following a period of more than one year of intensive work, on September 30th the Town of New Richmond officially launched its Family and Seniors Policy and the 2018-2021 Plan of Actions.

More than 150 people were present at the *Adrien-Gauvreau* Community Center to learn about the orientations, the values and the areas of intervention of this policy. A work of art representing the Seniors Policy was officially revealed. Noëlla Gagné, an artist from New Richmond, illustrated her vision of seniors in the community.

Thanks to the support of the Minister of the Family, this policy, that is the result of a vast consultation process within the community, includes actions that will meet the needs of its citizens. "We prepared this policy with the objective of maintaining an attractive and dynamic community that supports healthy lifestyle habits for both young families who wish to bring up their children in New Richmond and retired persons who wish to live here" stated the Councillor responsible for this dossier, Ms. Geneviève Branconnier.

According to the Mayor, Mr. Éric Dubé, the launching of this policy is one of the commitments made by the Municipal Council. "Our 2018-2021 Strategic Plan of Actions included this procedure. We are proud of this policy that includes concrete measures that directly affect citizens. An example is free membership to the *Vieux-Couvent* Municipal Library. All of the measures concord with our mission of animating the community and offering diversified and quality services that meet the expectations of our citizens, while respecting the pa-ying capacity of the population", stated Mr. Dubé.

According to the definition of the *Carrefour action municipale et famille (CAMF)*, "the family and seniors policy is a document that includes a plan of actions that enunciates a municipality's intention to welcome and support families and seniors with their challenges and their realities."

This policy is the result of a community effort, the participation of local organizations and citizens who are involved in their community. The Town would like to thank everyone who contributed to this process by participating in the public consultation, surveys, meetings or in any other way. This policy reflects the dynamic of the community and is an element of its vision to be "a town to experience".

You can recuperate electronic products (televisions, computers, computer screens, tablets, printers, cell phones, ink cartridges, scanners, video games, etc.) by taking them to the container that the Town of New Richmond has available to you at all times and that is located at the Municipal Garage (128 Boulevard Perron East. All other types of waste materials, such as construction materials, bulk materials, ground, rocks, etc, must be taken directly to the landfill site in Saint-Alphonse.

Automobile shelters



Car shelters, composed of mobile panels that are painted or stained, canvas, plastic, fibreglass panels or other conventional materials (a maximum of 2 materials can be used) are exclusively permitted between November 1st and May 1st each year and they must respect a minimal distance of 1,5 metres from the street or sidewalk curb, and be placed outside of the visibility triangle for a lot situated at the intersection of two streets. If no street or sidewalk curbs exist, the distance is measured from the street right-of-way.

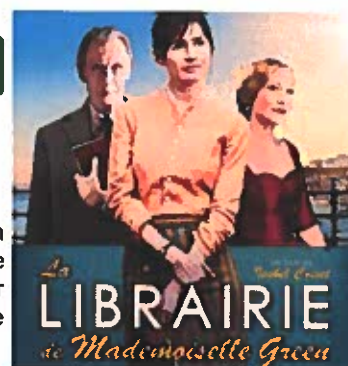

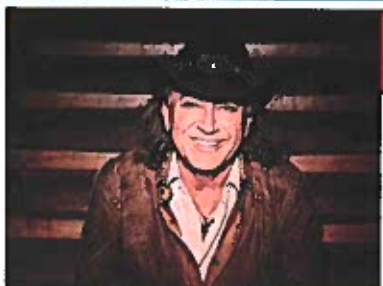

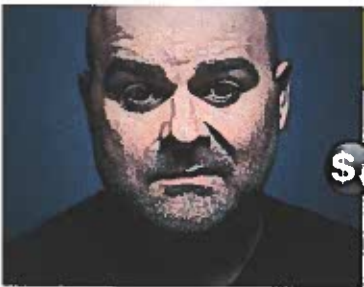
