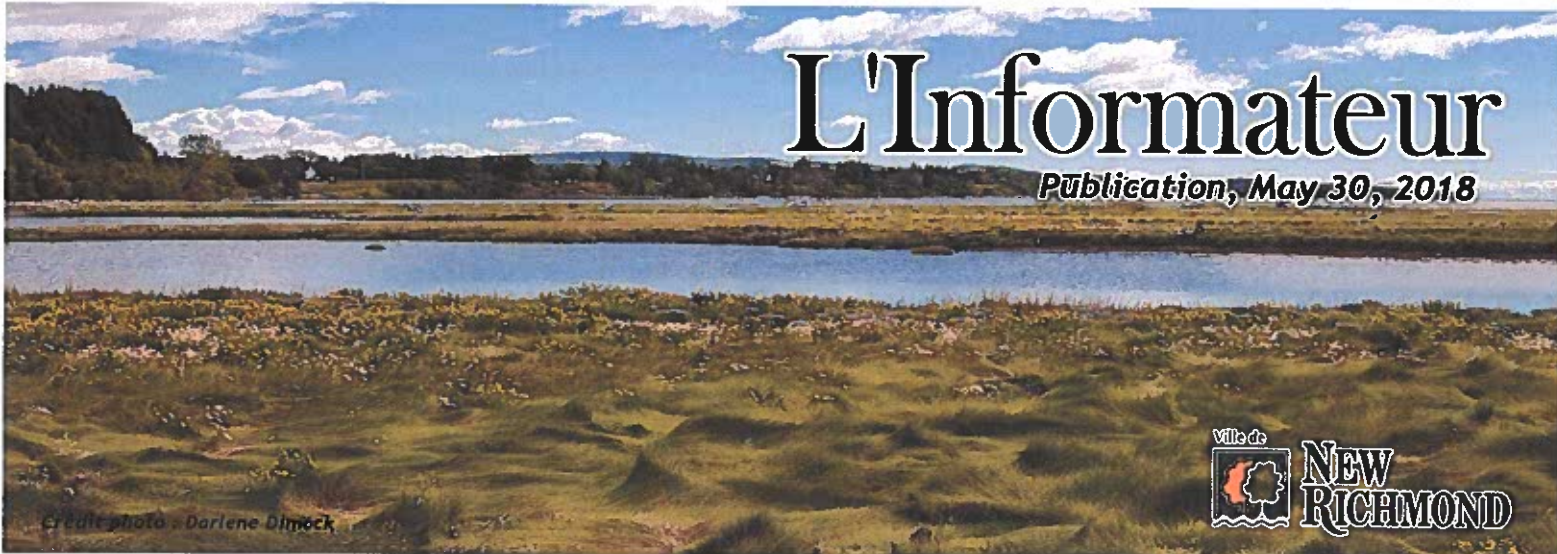

A message from the Mayor

Dear citizens :

On May 28th we presented our 2018-2021 Strategic Plan of Actions to the population. This plan was the result of a great deal of deliberation and many consultation meetings with the population over the past winter.

In order to properly orient its structure, we began by defining a vision that we revealed during this public event. This statement, that describes the projected future of our Town and the heritage that we wish to leave for future generations, reads as follows:

« As a central town, New Richmond plans to act as a regional leader in the commercial, industrial, culture and recreational-tourist sectors by implementing targeted actions based on demographical, economic and environmental realities ».

Consequently, we devised a game plan for upcoming years by implementing a series of measures in function of precise objectives in various sectors of activities: economic, recreation-tourist, cultural, sports and recreation, the well-being of the population, development, citizen participation, communications and essential services.

I invite you to consult the information related to this plan that is easily accessible on our website (www.villeneuve-richmond.com) or directly at the Town Hall where copies will be available.

The most significant measures of this plan consist of financial aid programs beginning in 2019 that will be available for exterior renovations of commercial buildings in the downtown sector, residential construction and lodgings, additional tourist accommodations in our municipality, in addition to aid for new agricultural enterprises.

We are persuaded that the measures in this plan will meet the current and future requirements of our population.

In closing, I would like to make two comments. Firstly, I would like to acknowledge the volunteers of our community who were honoured at a gala on May 27th. Once again, thank you for your contribution to our town. There were more than one hundred persons present and it was a pleasure to exchange with you.

The second is to extend a special welcome to our new Town Planning Director, Mr. Jean-Sébastien Bourque. He began work on May 23rd and will replace Mr. Richard Cormier who occupied this position for a period of 32 years!

Don't wait until the last minute!!

You have several options for the payment of your municipal taxes:

In person at the Town Hall: payment by cash, cheque, debit card or you can sign up for preauthorized payments (direct withdrawal);

By mail: send a series of post-dated cheques (please attach coupons);

By Internet: via your financial institution, please note that if you have one than one property, you must register the file number (matricule) for each one.

The date of reception of your payment is considered for the calculation of interest on the balance if necessary. **The Town is not responsible for postal or bank delays.** **The first time we receive your payment past the due date (or a partial payment), interest and penalties are only calculated on the overdue instalment.** If you make **late payments twice in the same year, you automatically lose** the right to instalments without interest and penalties, that is to say that interest and penalties are charged on the **outstanding balance**, in accordance with By-law 760-03. 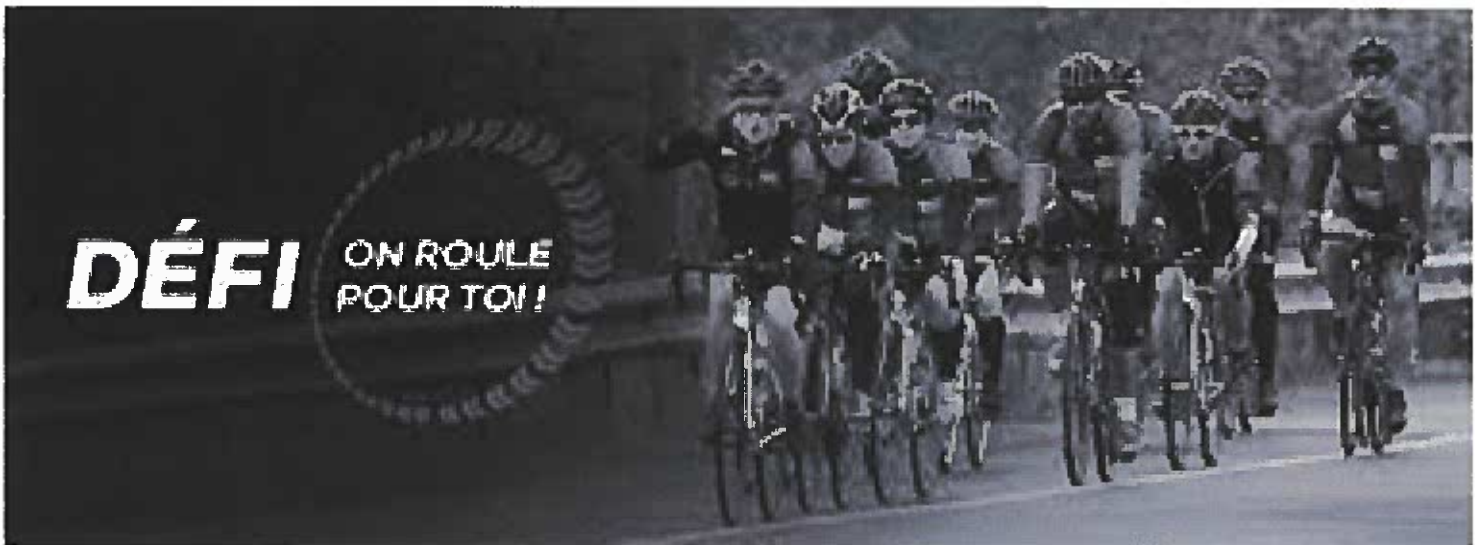



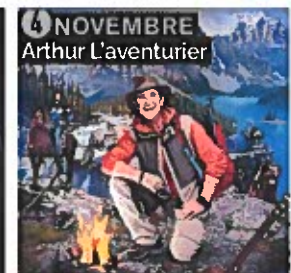
