A message from the Mayor

Dear citizens:

Spring is here and we will soon be busy with flowers and summer activities. For the moment, we are in the process of evaluating the past winter season. Economically speaking, the season was good for winter sports and related businesses. Obviously, there was an abundance of snow for snowmobiling and skiing! All in all and in spite of inconsistent weather conditions, the *Parc régional Petite-Cascapédia* had a good winter. By inconsistent weather conditions I am not referring to the amount of snowfall, but rather to the intense cold of January and the beginning of February that had a substantial impact on activities. In spite of this, we are happy with the results to date. The exact financial statements will be available in the next few weeks.

Unsurprisingly, we can state that costs for snow removal operations of the Town of New Richmond were higher than anticipated. Maintenance costs, for example, were much higher than usual due to the number of operations during the winter months. Work hours, fuel and related supplies all exceeded budget predictions. This situation is not unique to New Richmond and we are confident that we will be able to compensate for these budget differences between now and the end of the year.

We would like to inform you that the traditional «Volunteer Recognition Gala» with theme of «Volunteers lifting communities» will be held at the *Adrien-Gauvreau* Community Center in April. The Town of New Richmond will be honouring one of its most important resources: its citizens. It will be an occasion for us to thank everyone who volunteers for a cause, an event or a group. As I state every year, without your contribution, our town would not be what it is today. If you are interested, please join us this Sunday, April 14th from 11:00 to 14:00. Finally, I would like to remind you that following several weeks of forced closure, the Bruce-Ritchie Pool reopened on Saturday, March 30th. The large number of clients in attendance over the week-end proved they missed the pool when it was closed. Accompanied by experts, we are confident that we have identified the source of the problem. Finally, it seems that it is a combination of factors that caused the breakdown. Our insurance company is currently in the process of finalizing the case. It is too soon to estimate the costs for the Town in this dossier.

Second Draft of By-law 1091-19, entitled
« By-law modifying By-law 920-12 relative to conditional uses in the Town of New Richmond (Zone Rur.10 – 412 Perron Boulevard West) »

Objective of the draft by-law and request for approval by referendum

Following the public consultation meeting held on April 1, 2019 concerning the draft by-law entitled «By-law modifying By-law 920 -12 relative to conditional uses in the Town of New Richmond (Zone Rur.10 - 412 Perron Boulevard West) », the Municipal Council adopted a second draft of the by-law, bearing the number 1091-19. The objective of this by-law is to modify By-law 920-12 relative to conditional uses in the Town of New Richmond in order to add a conditional use in Zone Rur.10 namely a «Dog breeding domestic use in a primary residence ».

This second draft contains provisions that may be the object of a request by interested persons in the targeted zones, to the effect that the by-law containing them be submitted to approval by certain eligible voters, in accordance with the *Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities*. All persons who so request, may obtain a free copy of the summary of the second draft at the Town Hall, from Monday to Friday, between 8:00 and 16:00.

Identification of the concerned zones and the contiguous zones

The concerned zone is Rur.10 and the contiguous zones are Ea.23, Ea.24, Ea.25, Ea.26, Ec.3, Pa.3 and Ra/a.2. The description of these zones may be examined at the Municipal Office

Conditions determining the validity of a request

To be valid, a request must:

- Clearly indicate the concerned provision and the zone from which the request originates;
- Be received at the Municipal Office located at 99 Place Suzanne-Guité, in New Richmond, by 16:00 on April 11, 2019 the latest;
- Be signed by at least 12 interested persons from the zone from which it originates or by the majority of them if the number of interested persons in the zone does not exceed 21.

Interested Persons

Information to determine who are the interested persons having the right to sign a request concerning the provisions of the draft by-law is available at the Municipal Office during regular office hours.

Absence of requests

All the provisions of the second draft that have not been subjected to a valid request may be included in a by-law that does not require approval by eligible voters.

Residual materials Recyclable materials

Collection of large items : May 14 & 15, 2019

Objects must be separated and placed in piles according to the following categories and not be mixed up. The objects must be placed at the road before 6:00 AM. Employees will not separate items during this special collection.

If there are objects that are not accepted by the landfill site, if the objects are not separated and placed haphazardly in a trailer or if they are not placed at the road, **they will not be picked up**. All articles must absolutely be placed at the street (before 6:00 AM) on Tuesday May 14 and not Wednesday 15 (because they will not be picked up).

Categories of large items:

METAL	NON-METALLIC ITEMS
<p>Household appliances: stoves, refrigerators, freezers, washers and dryers; Bathubs; Non-contaminated empty reservoirs with a maximum of 1 100 litres; Pool pumps; Antennas, ramps, springboards and other similar long metal items.</p>	<p>Furniture; Rugs, floor covering; Showers, sinks, toilets, above ground pool liners; Branches, wood posts and other similar rigid long wooden objects measuring more than one (1) metre that are attached together.</p>

ELECTRONIC PRODUCTS:

You can recuperate electronic products (televisions, computers, computer screens, tablets, printers, cell phones, ink cartridges, scanners, video games, etc.) by taking them to the container that the Town of New Richmond container has available to you at all times and that is located at the Municipal Garage (128 Boulevard Perron East. All other types of waste materials, such as construction materials, bulk materials, ground, rocks, etc, must be taken directly to the landfill site in Saint-Alphonse.

A PAINT RECYCLING SERVICE IS NOW AVAILABLE

A container is now accessible at the Municipal Garage from Monday to Friday from 7:00 to 16:00. This partnership is an important element in the management of residual materials, in compliance with the Town's Durable Development Policy.

Don't wait until the last minute!!

You have several options for the payment of your municipal taxes:

In person at the Town Hall: payment by cash, cheque, debit card or you can sign up for preauthorized payments (direct withdrawal);

By mail: send a series of post-dated cheques (please attach coupons);

By Internet: via your financial institution, please note that if you have one than one property, you must register the file number (matricule) for each one.

The date of reception of your payment is considered for the calculation of interest on the balance if necessary. The Town is not responsible for postal or bank delays. The first time we receive your payment past the due date (or a partial payment), interest and penalties are only calculated on the overdue instalment. If you make late payments twice in the same year, you automatically lose the right to instalments without interest and penalties, that is to say that interest and penalties are charged on the outstanding balance, in accordance with By-law 760-03. 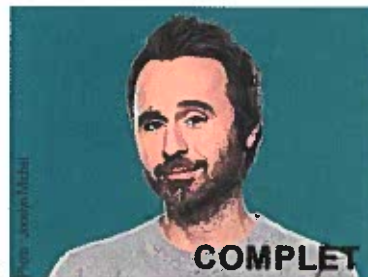
